



Sisters Shootout Series Tournament Rules and Information

- 1) **Your team will not be scheduled in the tournament bracket until your registration form and fee has been received.**
- 2) **Games will begin at 8:00 am on Saturday, and championship games will most likely begin at 6:00 pm on Sunday.**
- 3) **There will be no refunds without a 45-day written notice.**
- 4) **Prorated Tournament fees maybe made available if adverse weather conditions or other factors that may reduce attendance that affect game guarantee.**
- 5) **2-20 minute running halves with the last two minutes of each half stop clock if the score is within 15 points.**
- 6) **3 minute half times**
- 7) **3 time-outs each game and 1-20 second time out each half. 20 second time outs do not carry over.**
- 8) **Five minute warm up period between games.**
- 9) **Overtime periods are three minutes long, the final minute will be stop clock. If after one overtime period, the tie is not broken we will go to a sudden death format. The first team to score in sudden death is the winner.**
- 10) **Tie Breaker- A tie within a pool will be broken based on the least amount of points allowed in the two Saturday games combined.**
- 11) **5th and 6th grade teams must play man-to-man defense in the half court. You must press back court in man-to-man defense. No zone or trapping.**
- 12) **5th and 6th grade will use 28.5 ball.**
- 12) **7th and 8th grade may use full court press; however, if the lead becomes greater than 15 you may not press.**

- 13) **If you have a mixed team, you must play at the highest level of grade you have on your team.**
- 14) **Unsportsmanlike technical fouls will result in the opposing team:**
 - a) **Automatically receiving two points and possession of the ball, the player must sit out 2 minutes.**
 - b) **Any team receiving three technical fouls will result in a forfeit of that game.**
 - c) **Any coach, player or fan that receives 2 technical fouls in any one game will be removed from that game and the remainder of the tournament.**
- 15) **We will provide OSAA officials when available.**
- 16) **Admissions: All passes are good for the entire weekend, and local businesses will be offering discounts for flashing your pass. Family passes are \$15.00, and individual passes are \$10.00.**
- 17) **T-shirts and sweatshirts will be available for purchase at each location.**
- 18) **Medals will be provided for first, second, and third place teams within each bracket.**
