

TOURNAMENT RULES AND TIEBREAKERS

Tournament Rules

- 1) 2-20 minute running halves with the last two minutes of each half stop clock if score is within 15 points.
- 2) 3 minute half times
- 3) 3 time-outs each game & one 20 second time-out each half.
- 4) Five minute warm-up period between games.
- 5) Overtime periods are three minutes long, the final minute is stop clock. If after two overtime periods, the tie is not broken, we will go to a sudden death format. The first team to score in sudden death is the winner.
- 6) Fifth and sixth grade boys and girls must play **man to man defense** in the half court. You may, however, back court press with either zone or man defenses.
- 7) Fifth and sixth grade boys will use the intermediate size ball (28.5) unless both coaches agree to using a regulation ball.
- 8) Unsportsmanlike technical fouls will result in the opposing team automatically receiving **two points**, and **possession** of the ball. Any player, coach or fan who conducts themselves in an unsportsmanlike manner based on the opinion of the gym supervisor will be dismissed from the tournament.

TIEBREAKERS

- 1) Head to head results
- 2) The team to give up the **LEAST** amount of point in all games added up.
- 3) Greater difference in points. Points scored add all games together and points given up add all game together.
