- 1) Girls LAX
  - a. HS Coach recruitment efforts and plan; head coach must be 21 years of age therefor Olivia cannot be head coach season B. She is willing to be assistant coach. David teaches at SHS may be interested but would need to apply. Paul with introduce to Heather.

  - b. IS there field availability in March for a small jamoboree? Heather will follow up with Gary Thorsen at SHS.

  - a. Register with OSHLA
- 3) Youth LAX
  - a. BPRD moving forward with a LAX season and we need to report to them by 3/15 confirming our teams. Our youth teams will register through SPRD and SPRD will run the LAX program through BPRD
- 4) COVID schedule ("season B")
  - a. Update from OHSLA: The board has appealed to Oregon Health Authority, to reclassify our sport to minimal-moderate contact. This has already happened in Washington State, and NCAA. Stay tuned. The board is meeting next week to finalize the 2021 schedule, which as proposed has the following:
    - 4 /5/21- First Practice
    - 4/16/21 First Game date (after a minimum of 7-9 practices), consider practicing Sat and or Sun of first week
    - 5/3-4/2021 Last play dates.
    - 5/7-8/21 First round playoffs 32 teams (top 4 from each conference). Winners will advance to State Champs, Consolation bracket will play for the Cascade Cup.
    - 5/22/21 State Championships, likely Cascade Cup day prior This is dependent on the officials agreement to the above.
    - \*OSAA is encouraging "local" competition only, and from talking to the Summit AD they are have a very difficult time getting valley teams to host or travel during football season. Hopefully the restrictions will



lessen by the time spring sports roll around, and we can attempt some non-conference play
